- The Pharma CI Conference may publish the winner's submission on open platforms such as industry publications, websites and social media
- Please ensure your submissions are fully approved by your organization before submitting
- The jury will evaluate the submissions and make a decision
- The jury decisions are final and may not be disputed

Conference Session: Each award applicant is asked to provide a title and description for your session as you would like it to be displayed in the Pharma CI Conference literature, so that in the event that you do win, your information will be accurately reflected on-site at the event. (Description should reflect what the attendee will learn after hearing your session and be no longer than 100 words.)

Follow-Up: After your submission, we may contact you for additional information if needed. Please provide with your submission the information you deem relevant which may include an Internet URL, slides, demonstration or working illustration.
